

Haunted house now open on Broadway

Mad Dads and the Council Bluffs Jaycees have teamed up to give residents a scare this Halloween.

Beginning at 7 p.m. today, the organizations will open their haunted house at 212 E. Broadway to the public. The haunted house is located next to Taco Bell.

From now until Halloween, the house will be open to visitors — ghostly or otherwise — from 7 to 10 p.m. Sunday through Thursday and 7 p.m. to midnight Friday and Saturday.

The haunted house is handicapped accessible.

Rick Gilland, president of Mad Dads, said youth from around the city helped build and organize the house. Many of them will be doing double duty as ghouls, ghosts and witches, he said.

Admission is \$5 for adults. Children will be admitted at a reduced rate which has not yet been established.

All proceeds will go towards funding events for Council Bluffs youth, Gilland said.
