HBO to Air Another Madonna Concert

"Madonna — Live Down Under: 'The Girlie Show'" will air on the channel Nov. 20.

And get your VCRs ready: HBO will air the concert only once.

An HBO spokesman said that its Aug. 5, 1990, airing of "Madonna — Live! Blond Ambition World Tour" generated the highest ratings ever for an original HBO program. HBO has not aired a concert telecast since a Michael Jackson performance last October.
